The SSCP is the perfect course for personnel in non-security disciplines that require an understanding of security, but do not have information security as a primary part of their job description.

The SSCP credential is great for Information Systems Auditors; Application Programmers; System, Network and Database Administrators; Systems, Network Engineers; Business Unit Representatives and Systems Analysts.
